Since 2002, Hospital Sisters Mission Outreach has **embraced** the poor through provision of life-saving medical supplies and equipment. Today, we are reaching out to you with an opportunity to **embrace** newborn babies – the smallest and most vulnerable in these countries. Did you know that each year thousands of newborn babies in these areas do not survive the first week of life?

Newborn babies lose body temperature four times more quickly than adults. Low birth weight babies have even greater difficulty maintaining their temperature.

Sophisticated incubators and warmers keep babies warm in the United States. Many

developing world countries do not have incubators or reliable electricity to keep babies warm.

Embrace Nest is an alternative device that will help babies maintain their temperature, resulting in stable growth and health.

Embrace Nest – a miniature sleeping bag - uses special fabric developed by NASA and a removable wax insert which can be safely warmed with minimal electrical current. Mission Outreach has purchased **Embrace Nest** for a hospital in Nepal and we want to provide additional units to other locations. The \$250 cost is a small price to save a life.

All new mothers long to **embrace** a healthy baby. Please consider a generous year-end gift which will be applied to the cost of Embrace warmers and to the cost of sending medical equipment and supplies to those in need around the world.
